

BETS

As a rule, the guests make their own bets, but the Croupier is ready to grant your wishes if the timing of the game allows it. You have the possibility to place your bets with your own personal colour chips. These do not have a particular value and are issued in different colours only at the table. As a guest you determine the «value» of your colour chips, which will be visibly marked for everyone to see.

Since the personal colour chips themselves do not have a monetary value, these chips can only be used at the current table.

Of course, you can also play American Roulette with the usual value chips. After you have finished your game, we ask you to exchange your colour chips immediately for value chips before leaving the table. The minimum bets are indicated at each table.

HOW TO PLAY

The layout, also called «Tableau», consists of a table with lines, numbers, words and symbols. The core of the table is the roulette wheel which is divided up into 37 slots – from 0 to 36.

The numbers, which are not arranged in their natural, arithmetical sequence, are alternately placed in a red or black slot. Only the number 0 is placed in a green slot. On the Tableau, however, the numbers 0 to 36 are arranged in their natural sequence.

With the words «place your bets» the Croupier (dealer) opens the game and invites you to place your bets. You may now put your chips on your chosen bets on the Tableau. If you so wish, the Croupier will also place bets for you.

The Croupier will now set the wheel in motion and spin the ball in the opposite direction against the circular motion of the wheel. After the announcement «Rien ne va plus» or «No more bets, please» no more changes can be made on the Tableau.

As soon as the ball falls into a numbered pocket the winning number and colour are announced loud and clear.

The winning number will be marked with a «Dolly» for the Croupier to be able to make the payout. All successful bets in connection with the winning number will be paid out. A new game can begin.

**35:1
STRAIGHT UP**

Pays 35 times your bet
One of the 37 numbers on the Tableau from 0 to 36

**17:1
SPLIT**

Pays 17 times your bet
Two adjoining numbers, either in horizontal or vertical order, such as 25, 28, oder 25, 26

**11:1
STREET**

Pays 11 times your bet
Three consecutive number from a cross row of the Tableau, such as 16, 17, 18, or 0, 1, 2

**8:1
CORNER**

Pays 8 times your bet
Four numbers forming a square on the Tableau, such as 8, 9, 11, 12. The first four numbers – 0, 1, 2, 3 – are called Quatre Premier / First Four

**5-FACH
SIX LINE**

Pays 5 times your bet
Six consecutive numbers from two cross rows, such as 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6

When 0 wins, even chances, dozens and columns lose.

**2:1
DOZEN – COLUMN**

Pays twice your bet

Column
Twelve numbers

First Dozen
Twelve consecutive numbers from 1 to 12

Second Dozen
Twelve consecutive numbers from 13 to 24

Third Dozen
Twelve consecutive numbers from 25 to 36

**1:1
EVEN CHANCE**

Pays the equivalent of your bet

Odd
All odd numbers

19 to 36 – high
All numbers from 19 to 36

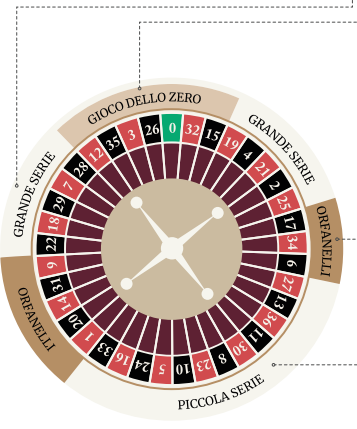
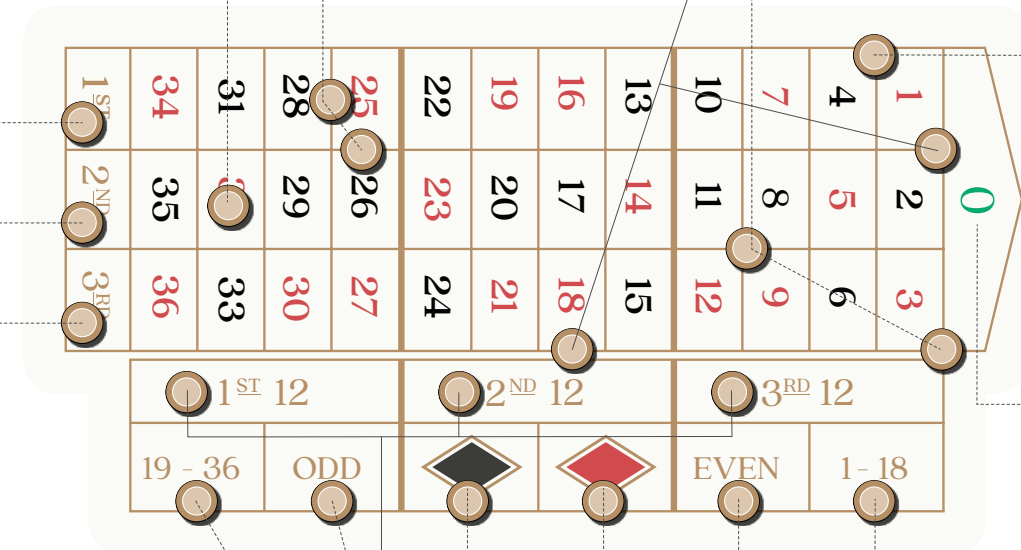
Black
All black numbers

Even
All even numbers

1 to 18 – low
All numbers from 1 to 18

Red
All red numbers

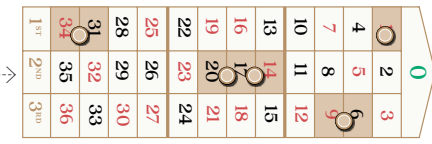

VOISONS
With 9 chips
You bet on 17 consecutive numbers in the wheel, with 9 chips.



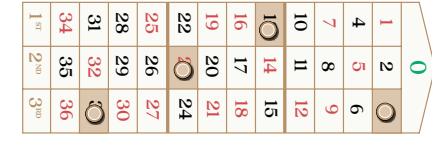
ZERO-GAME
With 4 chips
You bet on 7 consecutive numbers in the wheel, with 4 chips.



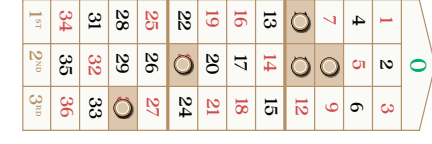
ORPHELINS
With 5 chips
You bet on 8 numbers, from two segments in the wheel, with 5 chips.



TIER
With 6 chips
You bet on 12 consecutive numbers in the wheel, with 6 chips.



FINAL
With 3 or 4 chips
You bet on numbers from a series with the same final digit, with 3 or 4 chips.



NEIGHBOURS
With 5 chips
You bet on 5 consecutive numbers in the wheel, with 5 chips.
